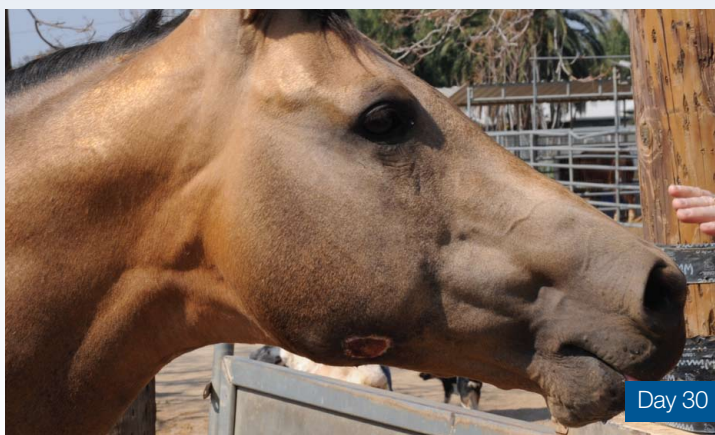

<b>Wound/Ailment:</b>	<p>Dryland Distemper (Pigeon Fever)</p> <p>Dryland Distemper, also known as Pigeon Fever, is a common infection seen in horses in the western U.S. It is caused by the bacteria <i>Corynebacterium pseudotuberculosis</i> which can live in the soil and typically enters the horse's body through wounds, broken skin or mucous membranes. The infection manifests itself through external abscesses, internal abscesses or limb infection.</p> <p>Typically treated with antibiotics, Vetericyn can be added to the treatment regimen of Dryland Distemper to speed healing. The stallion, Super High Noon, developed an abscess on his jaw as a result of Dryland Distemper. He was treated with Vetericyn and one round of SMZ by his trainer, Jauni Badger. Within 30 days, the abscess was healed.</p>
